Tender Notice

NCCF, Chennai Branch is inviting bid from its empaneled business associates of NCCF, Chennai Branch for the supply of groceries to BHEL Ltd (Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited), Tamil Nadu. All the interested empaneled bidders of NCCF, Chennai Branch are requested to submit their offers on or before 14.10.25, 4:00 pm. Bidder must prepare two envelope, envelopes -I containing details for sample and the envelope – II containing prices of selected samples. L1 among them will be awarded the contract after negotiations.

NCCF, Chennai Branch reserves all the rights to accept or reject all of bids received from business associates without assigning any reason.

Terms And Conditions

1. The rate quoted by the bidder will be valid for One Month.
2. The rate should include transport, handling, packaging, gunny bag cost and all taxes etc. inclusive of free delivery of grocery at BHEL canteen stores.
3. In case of failure by the supplier to deliver the required grocery items or suitable replacements within the stipulated time, any additional cost incurred by us (including transport and handling charges, if any) for procuring the items from the open market to meet urgent requirements will be recovered from the pending payments of the supplier.
4. GST Number should be mentioned all in your Delivery Challan and invoices.
5. The bidder must have an average annual turnover of at least 30% of the estimated contract value during the last three (3) financial years FY 2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-25 (Provisional) and relevant documents evidencing the same should be submitted along with the bid.
6. The bidder should have an Audited Balance sheets and Profit & Loss Statements, or a CA - Certificate Turnover Certificate.
7. The bidder must provide a positive net worth CA – Certificate.
8. The bidder must have successfully completed at least one similar supply work of value not less than 5 lakhs in the last 3 years. (Similar works include supply work order equivalent goods to Government Departments, PSUs, or reputed organizations)
9. The bidder should submit the copy of work orders, Completion Certificates, and Payment proofs.
10. NCCF reserves the right to cancel or amend this tender in alignment with BHEL's decisions. Any such changes shall be communicated to all bidders accordingly.

11. Please note that NCCF reserves the right to reject any bid that does not meet the required quality standards, delivery timelines, or demonstrates unsatisfactory past performance or for any other reason, at its sole discretion.
12. The bidder shall submit all relevant and material documents in support of its bid.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

13. Violation in any terms & conditions of this tender may lead to termination of the agreement.
14. NCCF reserves the rights to call for any additional information/documents from experienced firms/agency and same shall be submitted by them to NCCF within given time period.
15. NCCF reserves the right to cancel this tender in totality without assigning any reason.
16. It may kindly be noted that Government of India or any State Government in India shall not be a party to this transaction.
17. At any stage, if it is found that experienced firm/agency/proprietor, etc. has given incorrect and misleading certificate/information/document(s), NCCF shall free to take suitable action including cancellation of contract, blacklisting of the applicant, taking appropriate legal action, etc.
18. All the data, record, etc. should be maintained with confidentiality. There should be no breach of obligation on the part of firm, in case of breach of obligation, appropriate action will be taken against the firm.
19. In case of any ambiguity/ dispute in the interpretation of any of the clauses in this tender document, NCCF's interpretation of the clauses shall be final and binding on all applicants/parties.

Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices.

20. It is expected that the bidders who wish to apply for this tender have highest standards of ethics.
21. NCCF will reject the tender if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices while competing for this tender.
22. NCCF may declare a bidder ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated duration, to be awarded or contract if it at any time determines that the bidder is engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices during the execution of contract.
23. The terms and conditions as mentioned in the BHEL tender enquiry shall also be applicable.

Applicable Law, Jurisdiction and Dispute Resolution

- (i) This tender document and award of work under this tender document shall be constituted and the legal relation between the parties hereto shall be determined and governed according to the laws of the Republic of India and only courts at Delhi shall have the jurisdiction in all the matters arising out of / touching and/or concerning this agreement and parties to this agreement agree to irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of those courts for purpose of any such proceeding.

- (ii) All or any dispute arising out or touching upon or in relation to the terms of this tender document including the interpretation and validity of the terms thereto and the respective rights and obligations of the parties shall be settled amicably by mutual discussion/ direct informal negotiation. If the dispute is unable to be settled by mutual discussion/ direct informal negotiation within 30 days from the commencement of such discussion/ negotiation, the same shall be settled through arbitration. The arbitration proceedings shall be governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act of 1996 (as amended up to the date) or any statutory amendments / modifications thereof for the time being in the force. The seat & venue of the arbitration shall be at Delhi and language of arbitration shall be English.
- (iii) There shall be separate legal clauses pursuant to award of work and same shall be incorporated in Agreement. All the terms and conditions shall be dealt as per the Agreement to be executed between NCCF and successful bidder after tender process and terms & conditions of the Agreement shall prevail over the terms & condition of this tender document.

Force Majeure

If the performance of any party to the Contract is prevented, restricted, delayed or interfered by reason of riots, civil commotion, hostilities between nations, fire, explosion, cyclone, storms, flood, war, revolution, blockage or embargo, any law, order, proclamation, ordinance, demand or requirements of any Government or authority, strikes, shutdowns or labor disputes which are not instigated for the purpose of avoiding obligations herein, or any other circumstances beyond the control of the party affected, then notwithstanding anything here before contained, the party affected shall be excused from its performance to the extent such performance relates to such events, provided that the party so affected uses its best efforts to remove such cause of non-performance and when removed the party shall continue performance with utmost diligence.

The Party which is unable to fulfil its obligations under the contract must within 03 days of occurrence of any of the causes mentioned in this clause inform the other party of the existence or termination of the circumstances preventing the performance of the contract entered pursuant to this.
